The Environmental Review should look at existing industrial damage such as existing transmission lines, oil and gas developments as well as past hydroelectric dam projects on the Peace River. This region has been over-developed and its wildlife and farmland are suffering. The Site C Dam would be too much damage to a region already under strain.

The Environmental Review should look at if there is even a need for the Site C Dam project (we say there is not). Alternatives to the project should include a "no-go" option. We do not need the Site C Dam project.

The opportunity to comment at public meetings should be extended to BC's larger communities, including Kamloops, Kelowna, Nelson, Vancouver and Victoria. The proposed Site C Dam project would affect people's lives in all corners of the province, not just the Peace River Valley. The current process is undemocratic.
