Clarification to the text in the column titled [Environmental Criteria Used to Focus the Range of Background Conditions](#): the *Fisheries Act* applies to fish that are part of a commercial, recreational or Aboriginal fishery, or to fish that support such a fishery and to fish habitat on which fish depend directly or indirectly in order to carry out their life processes. Section 35(1) of the *Fisheries Act* prohibits serious harm unless authorized under Paragraph 35(2)(b) by the Minister of Fisheries, Oceans and the Canadian Coast Guard.
