Plaintiffs in on-going Federal Court Actions consolidated as Action T-165-01.

C. Interest in Project: This project occurs on the traditional lands of these people who have hunted, trapped, fished, collected berries and medicinal plants, have buried ancestors and conducted ceremonial activities on these traditional lands. Part of the Claim in Action T-165-01

- D. A Summary of Relevant Information: Elders have information regarding these traditional activities, these lands, the wildlife and environment of these lands as well as significant sites.
