Port Metro Vancouver (PMV) is pleased to submit to the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency the *Roberts Bank Terminal 2 Environmental Impact Statement – Marine Shipping Supplemental Report*.

This supplemental report addresses the requirements of section 17 of the *Updated Guidelines for the Preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement*, issued by the CEA Agency April 17, 2015, which require consideration of marine shipping outside PMV's jurisdiction (beyond PMV's care and control) to the 12 nautical mile limit of the Canadian territorial sea.
