

NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd – North Montney Project

How can I apply to participate in the hearing?

The National Energy Board received an application for the North Montney Project on 8 November 2013. The NEB has reviewed the application, determined it to be complete, and will hold a public hearing.

Those who wish to participate in the NEB hearing must apply to participate. Those who are directly affected by the proposed project will be allowed to participate in the hearing and those with relevant information or expertise may be allowed to participate.

The applications are due on or before noon on 19 March 2014.

To apply to participate, fill out the Application to Participate (ATP) form, a link to which is located on the Board's home page, www.neb-one.gc.ca. Click on "Major Applications and Projects" located on the left hand side of the main webpage, then click on "Nova Gas Transmission Ltd. – North Montney Project", and then click on "Apply to Participate" and submit it online. You will also be able to effect service automatically by submitting the form online. The online form will be available on the website on **18 February 2014.**
