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NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL) Towerbirch Expansion Project (the Project) Application of 2 September 2015 Potential Effect on Species Listed Under the Species at Risk Act (SARA)

Pursuant to the SARA, the National Energy Board (the Board or NEB) hereby advises the Minister of Environment and Climate Change that the above-noted Project, if approved and constructed, is likely to affect four species listed on Schedule 1 of the SARA and/or their habitat.

The listed wildlife species that are likely to be affected include:

- Canada warbler Schedule 1 threatened
- Olive-sided flycatcher Schedule 1 threatened
- Yellow rail Schedule 1 special concern
- Western toad Schedule 1 special concern

On 2 September 2015, NGTL applied to the NEB to construct and operate 87 km of new gas pipelines and associated facilities in northwest Alberta and northeast British Columbia including:

- Tower Lake Section (32 km of 762 mm OD pipe)
- Groundbirch Mainline Loop (55 km of 914 mm OD pipe)
- additional associated facilities, including meter stations, valves sites and pipeline tie-ins.

The Project is subject to an environmental assessment under the Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, 2012. Additional information about the environmental assessment is available through the Canadian Environmental Assessment Registry using reference number 80106.

The Board notes that Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) applied for, and was granted, Commenter standing in the GH-003-2015 Hearing. Should ECCC have specific advice related to the above matter, it may be provided in a Letter of Comment. The Board refers ECCC to Hearing Order GH-003-2015 for the steps and deadlines in the hearing process.
