The purpose of this letter is to inform Canadian Nuclear Laboratories (CNL) that CNSC staff have completed the licensing regulatory review of CNL's application [1 & 2] to construct the Near Surface Disposal Facility at the CRL site.

Based on CNSC staff's rigorous and systematic regulatory review and technical assessments of CNL's application and supporting documentation and additional licensing basis information, CNSC staff have deemed that CNL's application is complete in meeting the requirements of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act* and the associated regulations. In addition, CNSC staff recently notified CNL [3] that the final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for NSDF is acceptable.

In consideration of the above and in line with Step 5 of Table 2 of <u>Appendix A of the CNL-CNSC Administrative Protocol for the Near Surface Disposal Facility Project at CRL</u>, CNSC staff have the necessary information to proceed with the preparation of the Commission Member Document (CMD). Additionally, CNSC staff will inform the Commission Secretariat of staff's readiness to proceed to public hearings and will propose tentative dates. Please note that the Commission Secretariat will establish the hearing dates and CNL will be informed accordingly.

In the meantime, CNSC and CNL staff project's leads will continue working together, discuss and exchange information on any matter related to the NSDF Project, as deemed necessary.
