On May 31, 2022, the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) received Alberta Transportation's response to the Notice of Non-compliance issued by IAAC on April 27, 2022. I have reviewed the response provided and note that Alberta Transportation has taken steps to address the alleged non-compliance identified within the Notice of Non-compliance. I no longer allege, based on my review of the information provided, that as of May 31, 2022 Alberta Transportation is non-compliant with the conditions identified in the Notice of Non-compliance.
