On May 16, 2016, the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency (the Agency) accepted a project description for the Kitimat Clean Refinery Project (the Project). The Project meets the definition of a designated project under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*, 2012 (CEAA 2012), and the Agency is now determining whether a federal environmental assessment of the Project is required.

The determination as to whether a federal environmental assessment is required is based upon the likelihood for potential environmental effects within areas of federal jurisdiction as described in section 5 of CEAA 2012. The Agency requests that Environment and Climate Change Canada review the attached project description and provide advice on:

- The Project's potential environmental effects related to your departmental mandate and expertise as per section 11 of CEAA 2012;
- Whether your department has identified any environmental effects related to your departmental mandate and described in section 5 of CEAA 2012, beyond effects described in the project description; and
- iii. The potential environmental effects described in subsection 5(2) of CEAA 2012 related to the application of any power, duty, or function by your department.

The Agency requests your advice in order to inform the Agency's determination as to whether a federal environmental assessment is required for the Project. The Agency is required to determine whether an environmental assessment is required no later than July 1, 2016.
