The three-year time limit for the impact statement phase of the federal impact assessment process for the Webequie Supply Road Project (the Project) ends on February 24, 2023.

In the near future, Webequie First Nation plans to submit to the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (the Agency) a request to extend the time limit of the impact statement phase for the Project.

Once received, the Agency will invite the Indigenous communities listed in the Indigenous Engagement and Partnership Plan to submit input to inform the Agency's consideration of the request. Thirty days (30 days) will be available for communities to review the request and submit input to the Agency.
