Hello Chelsea,

Below is a summary of a meeting from a few weeks ago, to be posted to the registry.

A meeting was held between DFO, Fort McMurray First Nation #468, Golder Associates and Suncor on June 1, 2021 to discuss preliminary steps in the offsetting process for fish and fish habitat for the proposed Base Mine Expansion Project. Suncor and Golder outlined a conceptual offsetting plan for the Base Mine Expansion Project that would include the Gregoire Lake Watershed. Fort McMurray First Nation is included in the conceptual plan as a partner and provided information on areas of concern within the watershed that would benefit from offsetting measures. Fort McMurray First Nation #468 is located around Gregoire Lake and may take an active role in the conceptual offsetting project. DFO provided initial advice on how the offsetting policy applies to any conceptual offsetting plans that Suncor is considering, including in the Gregoire Lake Watershed.
