Subject: Comments invited on the potential impacts of the proposed Waterloo Airport Runway Project

On March 19, 2021, the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada accepted the Initial Project Description for the Waterloo Airport Runway Project from the Region of Waterloo International Airport (the proponent) as meeting the requirements of Schedule 1 of the *Information and Management of Time limits Regulations* under the *Impact Assessment Act* (IAA). As of today, the 180-day planning phase of the impact assessment has commenced.

The Agency is conducting a 30-day comment period on the Initial Project Description from March 19, 2021, to April 18, 2021, inviting the public, Indigenous groups and other jurisdictions to provide feedback related to the Project.

The Project

The Region of Waterloo International Airport is proposing to extend runway 14-32 from the current length of 1,250 metres to a final length of 2,134 metres, construct new access roads and a parallel taxiway, modify the runway approach lighting, and expand or relocate the terminal building. This work would improve the overall use of the airport, located in Breslau, Ontario, by upgrading the runway, which is currently capable of serving aircraft of Aircraft Group Number IIIA, so that it would become capable of serving aircraft of Aircraft Group Number IIIB.

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Invitation to submit comments

The objective of this letter is to invite your municipality to provide your views on the Project and its potential effects or impacts (both positive and negative) to the environment and your community, as well as how you would like to be engaged throughout the assessment process. Please review the Summary of the Project Description and provide your comments by **April 18, 2021**. A comment form (Enclosure 1) is provided for your convenience, or you may reply in a format of your choice.

The Agency will prepare a Summary of Issues² from comments received on the Initial Project Description from the public, Indigenous groups, federal authorities, and other participants. The Summary of Issues will be provided to the proponent. The proponent will then be required to submit a Detailed Project Description to the Agency that includes a response to the Summary of Issues and how the proponent plans to address the issues raised. The Agency will review and consider the proponent's documents and input from Indigenous groups and other participants to inform its decision on whether a federal impact assessment is required for the Project.

Should the Agency determine that a federal impact assessment is required, a second comment period will be held during the planning phase on the draft Public Participation Plan and the draft Tailored Impact Statement Guidelines.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Please note that any information submitted to the Agency to inform this project assessment will be made publicly available as part of the project file and on the Canadian Impact Assessment Registry. However, there are certain exceptions related to privacy, security or confidentiality.
