Following our February 8th meeting with the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada, our consultants and ourselves are hard at work preparing and compiling the information requested by the Agency for the analysis of the designation request under section 9 of the *Impact Assessment Act*. However, the deadline for our consultants and ourselves to provide the available information on potential adverse effects linked with the federal authority (February 18th) may prove too short, considering the scope of information requested.

The Agency advised Lambert Peat Moss to request of suspension of the timeline to accommodate filing of the requested information. Lambert Peat Moss is therefore requesting the Agency to suspend the federal timeline between February 18th and March 4th, allowing Lambert Peat Moss to provide the requested information.
