Dear Minister Guilbeault,

During a meeting between ourselves and the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada, held on March 23rd, the Agency brought to our attention that some information submitted by ourselves and our consultant was outdated and will need to be revised in order to accurately inform the effects assessment. This information was requested by the Agency for the analysis of the designation request under section 9 of the *Impact Assessment Act*. These updates may have a significant impact on the Project and need to be duly assessed by our consultants.

The Agency advised Lambert Peat Moss to request a suspension of the review timeline to allow for a thorough review of the potential impacts resulting from this new information, and if necessary, update the effects assessment. Lambert Peat Moss is therefore requesting the Agency to suspend the federal timeline as of March 23rd, allowing Lambert Peat Moss to assess the impacts and implications to the Project plans, and provide the corresponding revisions, where appropriate.
