Requirements of the Impact Assessment Act: Confidential Indigenous Knowledge

- Mandatory to consider all IK received, including confidential IK
- Report must state how IK was considered in the effects assessment
- Confidential IK not subject to Access to Information Act
- Exemptions under s. 119 of IAA (when it may be necessary to share confidential IK):
 - Publicly available IK
 - Procedural fairness/ natural justice
 - For legal proceedings
 - If regulations created (but no intent to do so)

Process Regarding Confidential Indigenous Knowledge

- Encourage Indigenous groups to summarize or generalize their IK so sensitive details are not submitted to the Committee
- Discuss confidential knowledge with Indigenous communities early on, advise of exemptions and the process
- ➤ If Indigenous community will share confidential IK, before the IK is submitted, document agreed-upon process with a letter or agreement (template for such a letter available; template for an agreement still in development)

Management of Confidential Indigenous Knowledge

- Ideally, receive confidential IK in an encrypted email or secure USB key
- Never post confidential IK to registry internet site
- For transparency and robust record of evidence, put notice on registry that confidential IK received (no content shared). Template for a registry notice available.
- ➤ Report needs to document how IK was used. Report should acknowledge that confidential IK was received, and where related to assessment/analysis and/or conclusions, summarize at a high level so confidential details are not revealed
