Subject: Aspen Power Station Project, Agency File No: 84525 Request for Temporary Time Limit Suspension

The Saskatchewan Power Corporation (SaskPower) received the Summary of Issues document from The Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (the Agency) on June 2, 2023. In its letter, the Agency indicated that the Detailed Project Description, including the response to the Summary of Issues, is to be provided by July 2, 2023.

Upon review of the Summary of Issues document, SaskPower has determined that more time is required to adequately address the issues and prepare the Detailed Project Description. SaskPower is requesting the Agency temporarily suspend the time limit, effective immediately, until the required information is provided.

SaskPower is committed to advancing the Project through the planning phase in a timely manner and does not anticipate a significant delay with the intent to submit the Detailed Project Description and response to the Summary of Issues some time in August 2023.
