Subject: Notification that the 180-day time limit for the Marmora Clean Energy Hub Project is suspended

The Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (the Agency) acknowledges the receipt of your written request to suspend the 180-day time limit for the Planning Phase for the Marmora Clean Energy Hub Project. The Agency has suspended the time limit as of July 14, 2023, day 56 of the 180-day time limit. The 180-day time limit is the period of time within which the Agency must provide Ontario Power Generation and Northland Power Inc. with a notice of commencement of the impact assessment, if the Agency decides that an impact assessment of the Marmora Clean Energy Hub Project is required.
