Subject: Request for Suspension per s. 9(5) of the *Impact Assessment Act* Canada, regarding the letter from the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) requesting Canadian Natural provide information pursuant to a Designation Request received by the IAAC in respect of the proposed Pathways CO₂ Transportation Network and Storage Hub Project

On December 3, 2024, Canadian Natural Resources Limited (Canadian Natural), on behalf of the members of the Pathways Alliance, received a letter from the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) advising that a designation request pursuant to subsection 9(1) of the *Impact Assessment Act* ('the Act') had been made with respect to the proposed Pathways CO₂ Transportation Network and Storage Hub Project ('the Project').

The December 3rd IAAC letter requested that Canadian Natural provide significant information and documents to the IAAC by Monday, December 23, 2024.

Given the significant amount of information requested and level of detail, as well as the status of the proposed Project, Canadian Natural respectfully requests that the submittal date of December 23, 2024 be suspended in accordance with subsection 9(5) of the Act.
