Mr. Clarke,

We are writing in response to your letter dated February 21, 2025 (**Letter**). In your Letter, the Agency requested further information as to the timing of a Pathways Alliance response to the Agency's original information request of December 3, 2025 (the **Request**) in light of the subsequent suspension to allow Pathways Alliance sufficient time to fully address the information requested by the Agency.

Pathways Alliance also received a letter dated January 28, 2025 from seven communities from the Treaty 6 First Nations (Beaver Lake Cree Nation, Cold Lake First Nations, Frog Lake First Nation, Heart Lake First Nation, Kehewin Cree Nation, Onion Lake Cree Nation, and Whitefish (Goodfish) Lake First Nation #128 (the **Nations**)) outlining the same concerns as the Nations communicated to the Agency in their letter to the Agency dated January 28, 2025 which is referred to in your Letter.

Pathways Alliance has prepared a detailed response to the Nations, addressing the various concerns raised in their letter. Since that response also addresses the same question from the Agency in your Letter regarding the timing of a response to the Request from Pathways Alliance, we have copied the Agency on our letter to the Nations and also attach it here. We have done this in effort to be transparent and consistent in our feedback to both the Agency and the Nations.
